#### **TROPHIES & ROSETTES**

All winners will receive rosettes (no flat ribbons) and some placements will also receive an additional gift as indicated below. All exhibitors will receive a small memento for participating.

#### **SHOW TROPHIES**

Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Best of Winner's Dog and Winner's Bitch, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Award of Merit (2), and Best Owner Handled will receive a Rosette plus a crystal piece.

#### CHALLENGE TROPHIES

For permanent possession Challenge Trophies must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. Each show's winner will be memorialized on an engraved plate affixed to the trophy base. If a winner has won 3 times, they take home the prize associated with that trophy. The trophy base with the winner names remains in the possession of the BFCSD for perpetual tracking of past winners. The BFCSD does not offer challenge trophies at every specialty show. Refer to the Premium List for each year to see at which shows they were offered. Prizes associated with each trophy may vary from year to year and the BFCSD reserves the right to make substitutions of similar style or value.

# PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Bichon Frise that are <u>6 months of age</u> and <u>under 15 months of age</u> on the day of the show. Champions of Record and dogs with major points <u>are</u> eligible. **Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler.** For the purpose of our Sweepstakes competition, Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, accepted money for handling dogs at a dog show, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay during the last 24 months. Dogs may not be exhibited by current (within the last 24 months) assistants and/or household members of a professional handler. <u>All entries in Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered</u>

in a Regular Class at this Specialty. Entry shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for Regular Classes. You must complete the regular AKC entry form and enter the word SWEEPSTAKES in the box that says "Additional Classes". Entry Fee for the Puppy Sweepstakes shall be \$25.00, plus the entry fee for the Regular Class.

#### PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATIONS

Dogs, 6 and under 9 months	Bitches, 6 and under 9 months
Dogs, 9 and under 12 months	Bitches, 9 and under 12 months
Dogs, 12 and under 15 months	Bitches, 12 and under 15 months

Winners of the 6 months through 15 months Classes will compete for Best in Puppy Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Puppy Sweepstakes. First through fourth place rosettes will be awarded in the Puppy Sweepstakes Classes. Best in Puppy Sweepstakes will receive a Pink and Green Rosette and a crystal piece. Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Puppy Sweepstakes will receive a Lavender Rosette and a crystal piece.

#### SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

15% of the total entry fees will be retained for Club expenses. The remainder will be divided into two (2) equal parts as follows. Best Puppy in Sweepstakes (50%), Best of Opposite Sex to Best Puppy in Sweepstakes (50%),

#### AWARD OF MERIT

The judge may award an Award of Merit to up to two of all <u>specials</u> entered in the Best of Breed competition. Recipients of the Award of Merit will receive a rosette with the words "Award of Merit" inscribed on it and a crystal piece.

#### NATIONAL OWNER HANDLED SERIES COMPETITION

The Bichon Frise Club of San Diego is pleased to offer NOHS at the Saturday show as part of their designated Specialty show. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. All AKC rules and regulations pertaining to NOHS events will apply to this competition. Best of Breed Owner Handled will receive Owner Handled points, a rosette and a crystal piece. There may be no All-Breed NOHS Group Competition unless the Silver Bay Kennel Club decides to offer it that day.

#### **NEW TITLE ROSETTES**

Any Bichon finishing an AKC Champion or Grand Champion title on Friday, Saturday or Sunday will receive a New Title rosette from the Bichon Frise Club of San Diego.

## PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS

This is a non-competitive Parade in which the dog may or may not be entered in a regular class at this show; however, all dogs MUST be holders of an American Kennel Club Conformation, Working or Performance Title. Each entrant will receive a large rosette with the dog's name and titles imprinted on it. Dogs must be pre-entered using the Jack Bradshaw Superintendent paper or online forms. Entry fee is \$25.00 per dog. You must complete the regular AKC entry form and enter the word PARADE in the box that says "Dog Show Class" if you are only entering the parade. If you are entering the conformation show then enter your usual class in the "Dog Show Class" box and then enter PARADE in the "Additional Classes" box. Next, you need to complete this Biography form and send this form to the Show Chairman by the entry closing date of Wednesday, 2/7/24, 6 p.m. PST.
